Dear Parents,

As I have not written for a long time I suppose you are anxious to here from me. I am well as could be, and we have very fine time too, we are fortifying a hill near camp I was at work on it all last Sunday. help building a road up, it is the largest and steepest hill I ever was on.

I received a letter from Bob two weeks he says he is well, and they here that snow then. we have had had some pretty cold weather but snow yet. we gave up our old muskets up yesterday and received new ones we have Belgian Rifles. we are the best armed
